This program represents a unique opportunity for electrophysiologists in Latin America to do an educational rotation for one week in the ***Department of Electrophysiology at the Memorial Regional Hospital*** in Miami, South Florida.

The program offers the opportunity to participate in our conferences and to observe the implantation of defibrillators, cardiac resynchronization therapy and complex ablation cases (Atrial Fibrillation ablation, PVC ablation or VT ablation).

Program Objectives

- To expose the participants to different complex ablation techniques and implantable cardiac device techniques
- To build a foundation for future collaboration in electrophysiology across Latin America and the United States

Curriculum

- Implantation of single/dual chamber defibrillator
- Implantation of a resynchronization device (Biventricular ICD).
- Complex ablation cases (Atrial Fibrillation ablation, Premature Ventricular Contraction ablation and/or Ventricular tachycardia ablation).
- Fluoroless Atrial Fibrillation Ablation Technique
- Cardiac Anatomy session
- Half a day on the EP Simulator
